

## 21st Young Artists Concerto Competition Sunday, November 19th, 2023

## **Competition Rules**

## Contestants must

- be a resident of the <u>Hampton Roads Area</u> (including Williamsburg).
- submit a completed application form before due date November 6th, 2023
- If using US mail, applications must be mailed on or before November 4th
- Be age 12 through 21 at the time of the competition and the March concert
- Submit a \$25.00 application fee
- Submit a letter of reference from your school music director or private teacher
- Perform with and provide an accompanist
- Bring 3 copies of the music to the audition for the judges
- Check a catalog, (e.g. Lucks), for the availability of orchestral parts and score for your chosen concerto\*
- Be able to attend at least three rehearsals with YRSO to prepare for the concert

## Procedures

- Previous competition winners must wait one year before reapplying.
- Instrumental pieces must be one movement from standard concerto repertoire. Vocal
  works may be one long, two medium, or three short arias from an opera, musical, or a
  song cycle for voice and orchestra.
- Due to issues with instrument availability, we are unable to include pianists this year.
- Pieces should not exceed ten minutes in length. If necessary, portions of longer pieces may be cut.
- All orchestral accompaniments must be available for purchase or rental by YRSO.
- Contestants will be selected on the basis of the submission of all materials and fees on time, the completeness of the application form, the letter of reference, the availability and cost of orchestra parts for the concerto, the comparative level of difficulty or artistry required of the music, and the number of applicants.
- Selected contestants will be notified via e-mail or phone by November 8th. Application fee will be refunded for those who were not chosen to audition.
